UNIQUE FEATURES OF THE PROGRAMME

1. Choice Based Credit & Grading System (CBCGS)[introduced in 2017-18].
2. Four Semesters for the Programme & Four Courses per Semester.
3. Marks per Course: 100 - Internal (40%) & External (60%).
4. Internal Test for each Course in every semester –conducted by the College.
5. Semester Examination (External) in every semester - conducted by University.
6. Minimum marks for passing: 40% in both internal & external separately.
7. Automatic promotion to Semester II, III and IV, if terms are kept / minimum attendance 75% is maintained.
8. Students can appear for any semester exam (I to IV) irrespective of the status of results of earlier semesters. But Semester IV results will be released only after clearing all semester exams.
9. The programme is governed by University of Mumbai. Hence, all guidelines issued are subject to changes as per the directives issued by University from time to time. (Please visit regularly University website - www.mu.ac.in)

Steps in filling Online College Admission Form

Go to - <https://enrollonline.co.in/Registration/Apply/GNCM>

1. Click on **“Go to Sign up”**.
Fill the details as required. Create **“Username” & “Password”** of your choice.
2. Click on **“Register”** You will get a message as **“Registered successfully!”**.
Username and Password sent on Registered Mobile No. **“OK”**.
3. Click on **“OK”**. You will get a Page for – **“Username and Password”**
4. Enter Username and Password and Click **“Login”**
5. A new page opens with the following : Apply for – **“ Please Select ”**
6. Click on **“Please Select”**. You will get **“Postgraduate”**
7. Select **“Postgraduate”** and click **“Continue”**
8. Fill in all the details under various sections: **Personal Details, Address, Education, upload Photo & Signature, Course Selection, Last Qualifying exam., Documents, Subject, Payment and Confirm application** in the subsequent pages as per the instructions.
9. **Documents to be uploaded with admission form:-**

 - 2) **B.Sc. all Semester Marksheets.**
 - 3) H.S.C. Marksheet
 - 4) Gap Certificate (if applicable)

 - 8) NOC from previous College.
10. In each section, Click **“Save & Next”** after filling the required details to proceed to the next section.
11. Students must pay the registration fees of **Rs.100/-** only through the online process.

12. At the last stage, Click “**CONFIRM APPLICATION**”

(**Note:** Before clicking confirm application, Click “**PREVIEW APPLICATION**” to ensure the correctness of entire process and information filled in.)

13. **Keep printout of both Application Form and Registration Fees Receipt** for your reference.

Students will be admitted on the basis of merit list. The fees should be paid immediately on receiving the confirmation message/mail.

The claim will be lost if the payment is not done by the next day after receiving the confirmation message/mail.

3. **Gap Certificate (GC)**- in the form of an affidavit [only for those students who have passed T.Y. in 2018-19 or earlier].
4. **Eligibility Status Report & Transfer Certificate** [for students from other Universities].
